An appointment must be made to collect uniform that you have ordered online via WisePay. Appointments are available at the following times:

Monday 20 June until Thursday 14 July - 2.45pm-3.45pm

Saturday 9 July – 9.00am – 1.00pm (limited availability left)

Monday – Thursdays throughout the summer holidays between 10.00am-2.00pm

Please note the **last appointment date is 25 August 2016**. This is to ensure that your child has the correct uniform to start the new term in September. After this date any uniform you wish to purchase must be ordered via our on line payment system, Wise Pay. These items will be available for collection from the school shop 48 hours after purchase, between the hours of **8.00am-8.30am in term time only**

**From September the school will be going cashless. We will only accept payments for food, trips, uniform, books etc via our on line system Wise Pay. Please call the finance office if you need a reminder of your log in details.**
